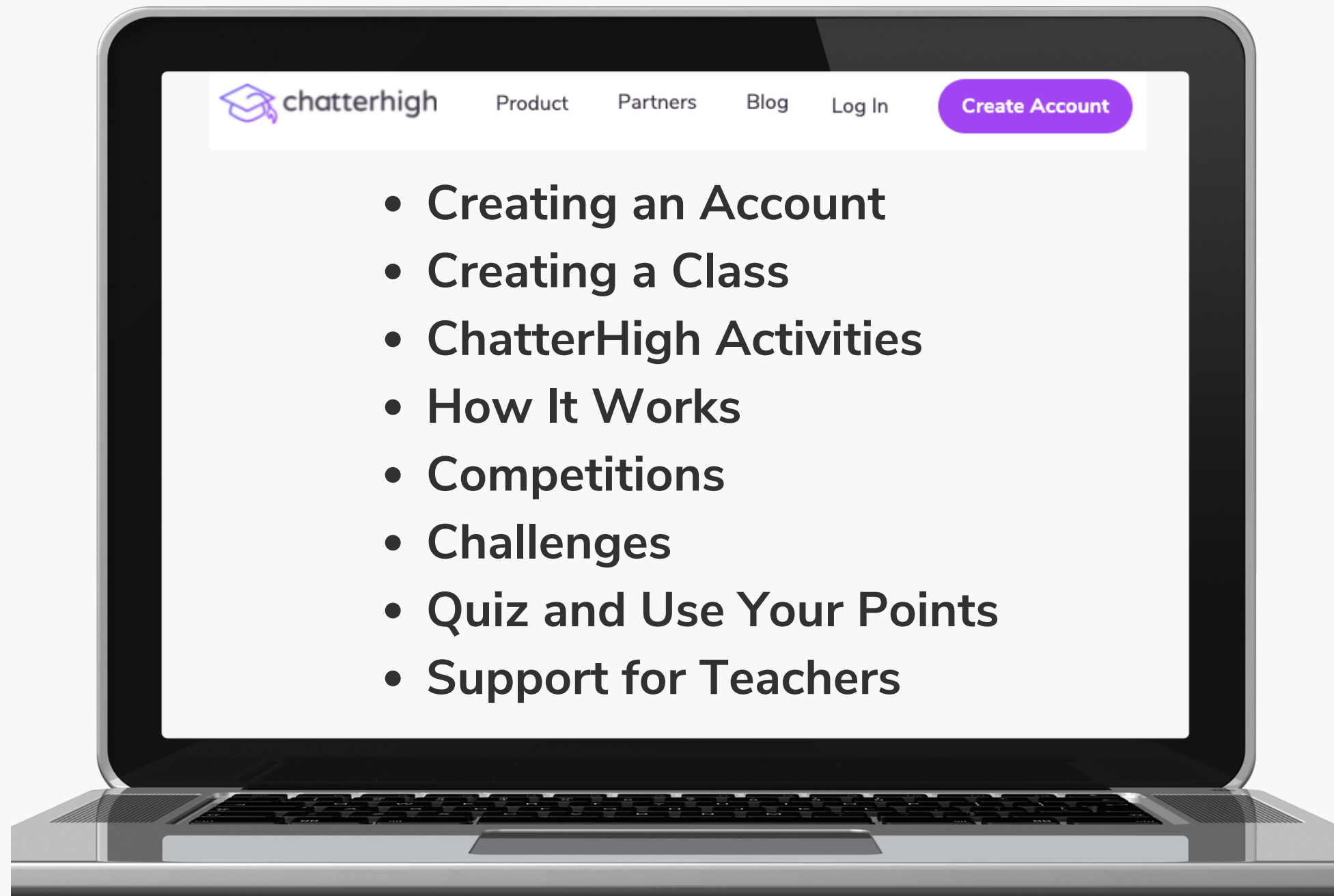


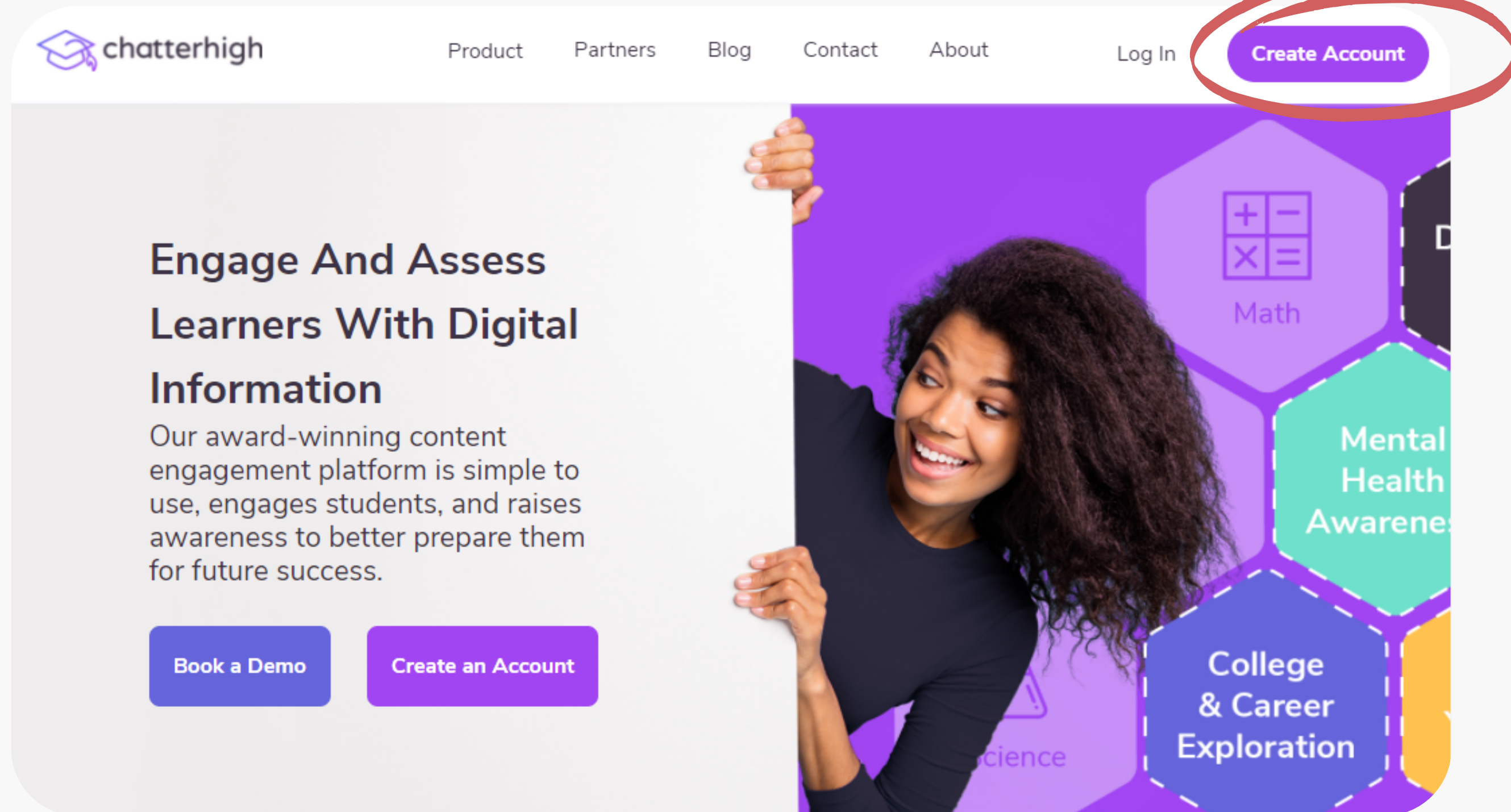
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Step 1: Create Your Account

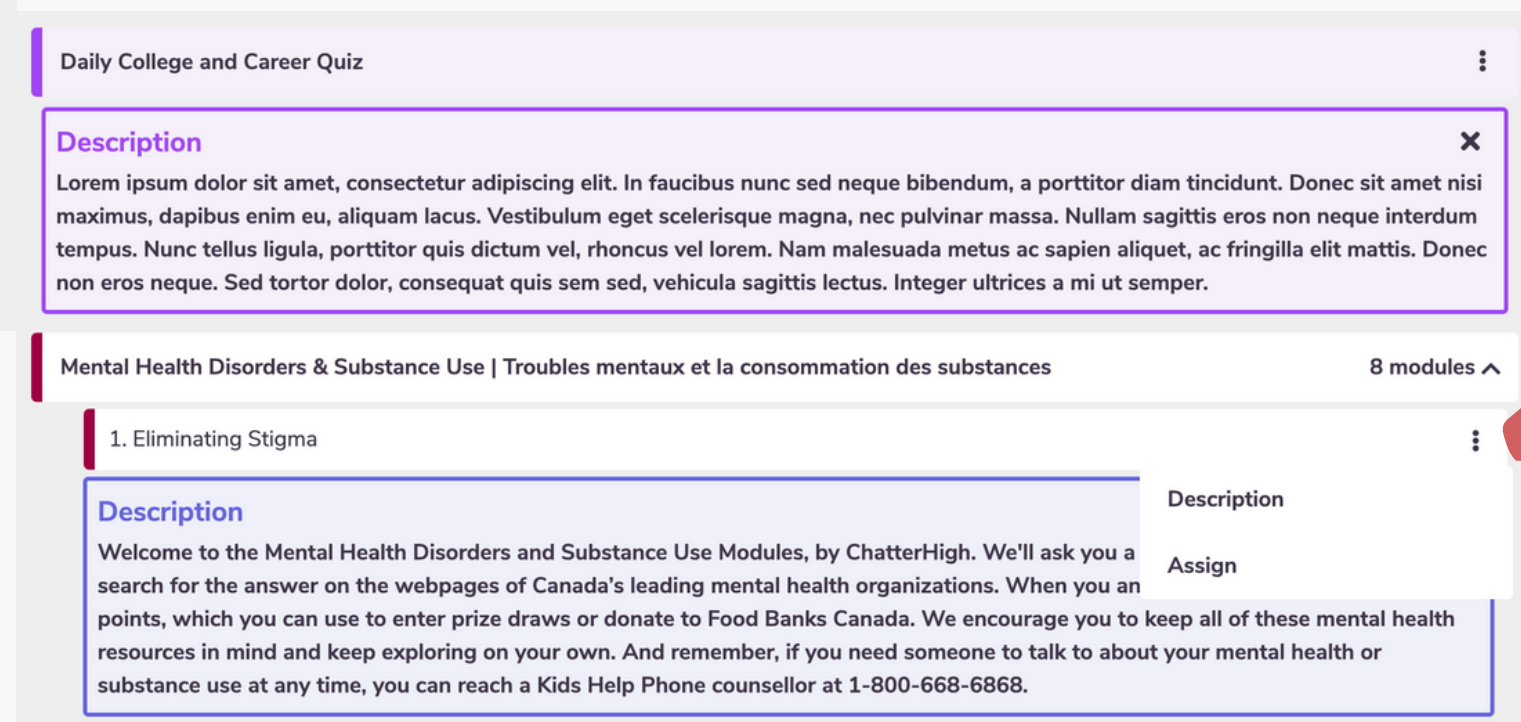
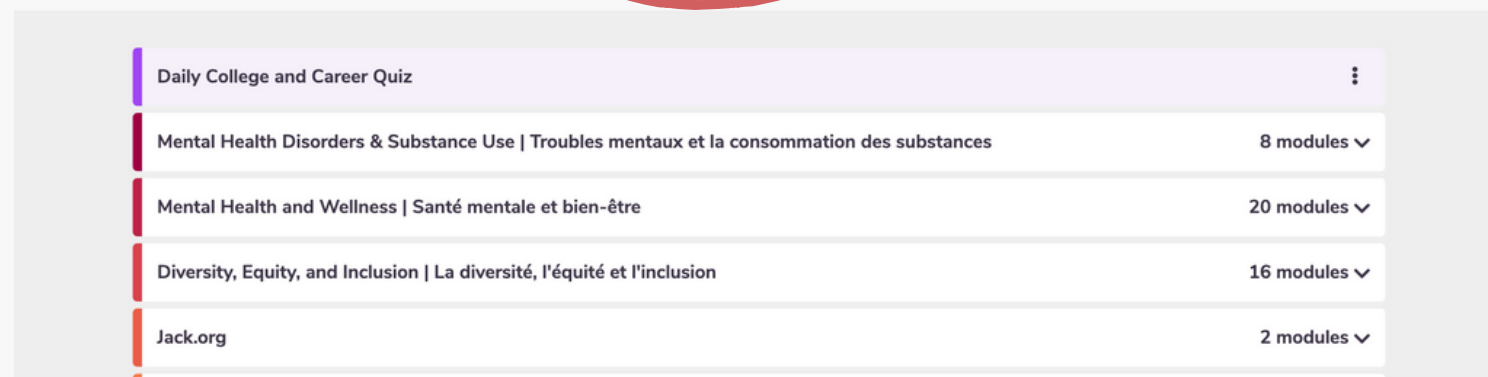
In your classes, you can assign content and monitor your student's progress.

ChatterHigh Activities

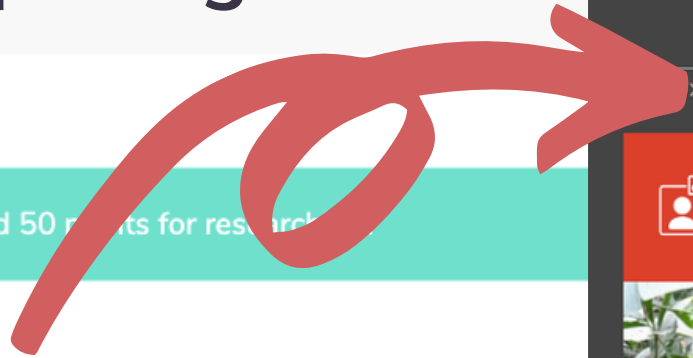
